Our track and field team had an incredible showing at the **CAA State Championships** this weekend, with our Varsity Boys placing 5th out of 28 schools! Leading the charge, Noah became the 800m State Champion and set a new CAA State Record in the 1600m with a time of 4:37. In field events, Ash and Mason made school history by setting new records in Discus and Shotput, with Ash securing 3rd place in both events. The momentum continued on the track as our boys' 4x400m and 4x800m relay teams both shattered school records.
